

## Extract from the Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan “On Enforcement”

### Article 13. Time Limits for Submitting Writs of Execution for Enforcement

13.1. Writs of execution shall be submitted for enforcement within the following time limits:

13.1.1. Except for the cases specified in Articles 13.1.3-2, 13.1.4-1, and 13.1.5 of this Law, writs of execution and court orders issued on the basis of court decisions — within one month;

13.1.2. Writs of execution issued on the basis of court rulings on the adoption of measures securing a claim — immediately;

13.1.3. Notarial execution endorsements — immediately;

13.1.3-1. Except for the cases specified in Article 13.1.3-2 of this Law, decisions of authorities (officials) empowered to consider cases on administrative offences — within ten days;

13.1.3-2. Decisions imposing an administrative penalty in the form of a fine — within the time limits established by Article 150 of the Code of Administrative Offences of the Republic of Azerbaijan;

13.1.4. Writs of execution issued on the basis of foreign court decisions — within three years;

13.1.4-1. Writs of execution issued on the basis of court decisions for the recovery of maintenance funds, including alimony — immediately;

13.1.4-2. Except for the case specified in Article 13.1.4-3 of this Law, writs of execution issued on the basis of awards of foreign and domestic arbitral tribunals — within one month;

13.1.4-3. Writs of execution issued on the basis of court decisions on the recognition and enforcement of interim measures granted by arbitral tribunals — immediately;

13.1.5. Writs of execution issued on the basis of court decisions granting a short-term protection order or a long-term protection order to a person subjected to domestic violence — immediately.

13.2. The time limits established in Article 13.1 of this Law shall be calculated as follows:

13.2.1. In the case of submitting for enforcement writs of execution specified in Articles 13.1.1, 13.1.4, and 13.1.4-2 of this Law (except court orders) — from the date when the court decision becomes legally binding, or when the period for the suspension or deferment of its enforcement expires; if the court decision is to be enforced immediately — from the day following the date of its adoption;

13.2.2. In the case of submitting court orders for enforcement — after ten days from the date of their issuance;

13.2.3. In the case of submitting for enforcement writs of execution specified in Article 13.1.3 of this Law — from the date of adoption of the relevant decision.
